

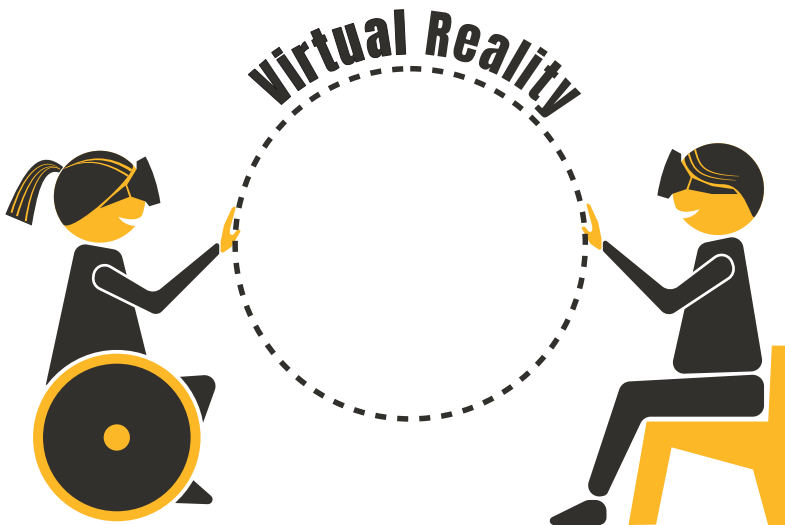
Virtual reality (VR) as a tool supporting vocational activation people with disabilities?

Education in Using Virtual Reality
in Supported Employment
and Career Counselling

Partners from 5 countries are developing the digital competences of 16 career counsellors and supported employment trainers to incorporate VR tools into support processes for clients with disabilities.

A team of counsellors and trainers are trained to...

- create VR lesson scenarios tailored to the needs of individual groups of clients,
- record 360 degree videos,
- develop virtual workshops on the VIAR 360 platform.



Counsellors and trainers prepare two types of virtual scenarios as part of the project:

- developing soft competences of clients, e.g. communication skills,
- raising the level of hard competence of people with disabilities, e.g. machine operation or preparation of meals in a restaurant.



The inclusion of VR tools in the vocational activation of people with disabilities brings benefits for all parties as well as...

- assistance for counsellors and employers in preparing clients for employment in various positions,
- supporting recruitment processes in companies,
- a safe confrontation of job candidates with the realities of a particular job position.




The community of counsellors and supported employment trainers will gain access to practical products of the project:

- package of recommendations for the use of virtual reality – recommendations for the process of implementing VR in support processes for above clients,
- a catalog of good practices with virtual occupy scenarios.

VR in the area of career counselling and social services for people with disabilities is becoming a reality in our project!
